Abstract for Session 4

Japanese Government has decided not to sign or ratify the NWPT. This should not be the end of Japanese mission in its efforts for Nuclear Disarmament. Japan should carry a new mission in NWPT as an observer state. Possible and necessary contributions by Japan would be (1) victim assistance and environmental remediation (Article 6), (2) peace and disarmament education (Preamble), (3) making competent international authority for verification of nuclear weapon and programs (Article 4), (4) persuade other “Umbrella States” to join these contributions.
