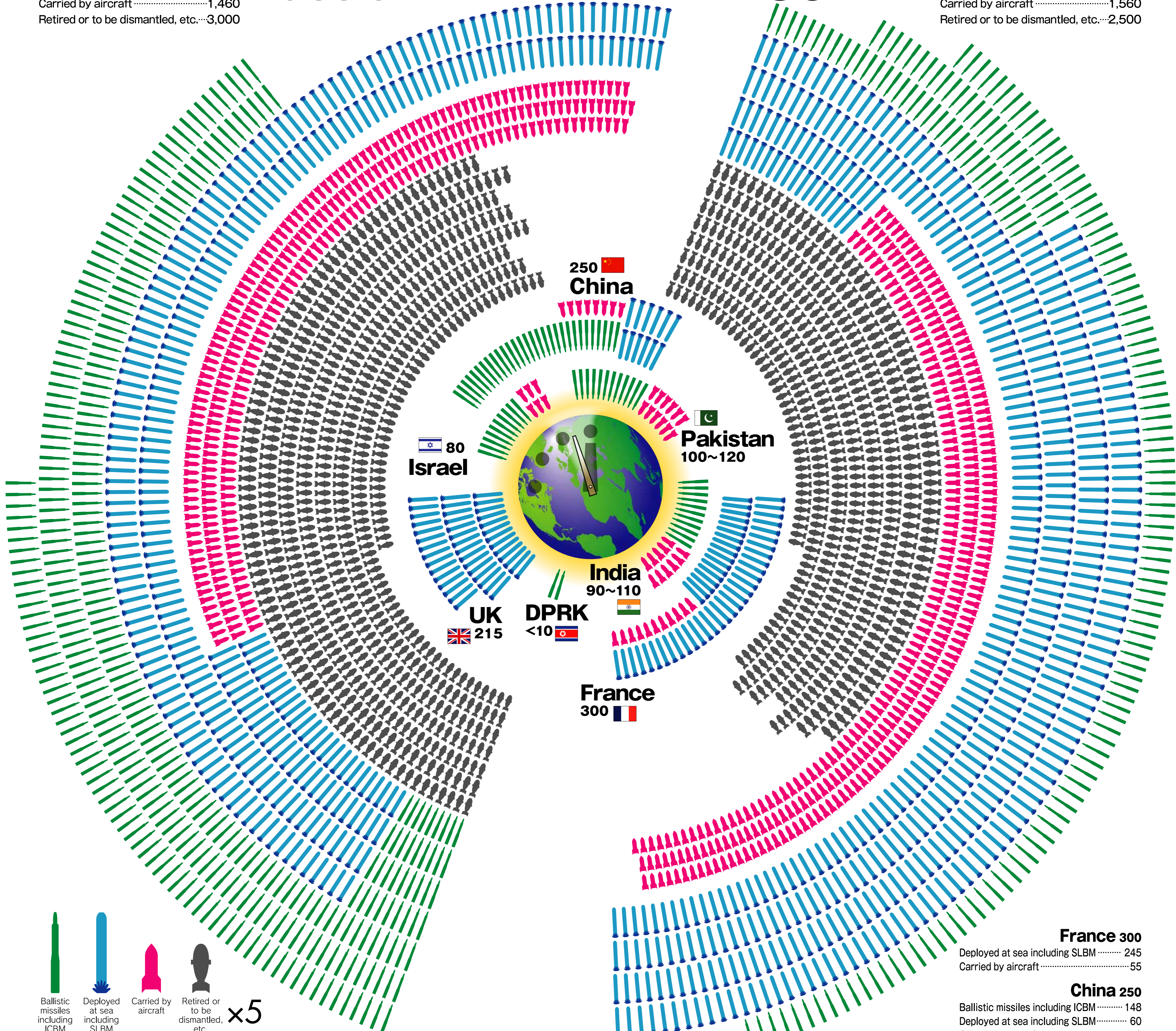

The Doomsday Clock is a symbol of the threat of nuclear annihilation. On the clock, midnight is the time of total destruction of humanity, and the minutes to midnight illustrate how close we are to such a "doomsday." Currently it is "3 minutes to midnight."
