1 Begin a strategic security dialogue with the United States.

Provide transparency about the full capacity of North Korea's nuclear inventory, including warhead numbers, silos, and fissile material.

Halt development of ground-based, intermediate-range missiles and encourage all Northeast Asian governments to do the same.

Negotiate a ban on low-yield "tactical" nuclear weapons with the United States and China.

Negotiate a "no-dead-hand" (fail deadly) nuclear restriction with China and the United States.

Support efforts to elevate the CTBT, including a principle of "no-first test."

Move toward a nuclear-weapons-free zone in Northeast Asia by negotiating a monitored, mutual ban on nuclear weapons within the Exclusive Economic Zones (200 nautical miles) of the Korean Peninsula's coastlines.

Support a freeze of advanced conventional weapons and reallocate 2% of the defense budget to economic development.

Commit to a "No Leadership Assassinations and No Forced Regime Change" pledge.

Participate in the development of a region-wide missile launch notification regime.
